First Movement (Allegro) Form: Sonata Form. D Major. EXPOSITION: Bars 1-9: First Subject in Tonic. It should be noted that the first phrase is written in unison, and that the second one is lengthened to five bars by repetition in Bars 5-6. The semiquaver (sixteenth note) figures (Bars 7 and 8) form a descending melodic sequence, ending with a perfect cadence in the tonic, Bar 9.

Bars 12-17: Bridge-passage or Transition. The transition consists of a series of scale passages, those in Bars 12-14 forming a free melodic sequence. Bars 17-34: Second Subject in F major (Dominant). The second subject contains only one theme/section, which is much prolonged by sectional and cadential repetitions. Bars 22-26 form a short sequence in which the parts are inverted bar by bar.

Mozart 's Piano Sonata No. 7 in C major, K. 284b (K. 309), was composed in Mannheim in October and November of 1777, while he and his mother were on a lengthy trip that would take them to Paris the next spring. Tragically and unexpectedly, Mozart 's mother would die there on July 3, 1778.

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Piano Sonata No. 9 in D major, K. 311 / 284c, was written on the composer's stay in Augsburg and Mannheim in November-December 1777, and is contemporaneous with his Sonata K. 309 (Mozart wrote his Sonata K. 310 in the summer of the following year, in Paris). The three sonatas K. 309-311 were published as a set 'Opus IV' in about 1782, by Franz Joseph Heina in Paris.
