A literacy center is one of several learning stations arranged in a classroom designed for students to visit and learn independently. Children often select a literacy center where they can work by themselves or in a small group of children. Literacy centers within an elementary school classroom feature a variety of stations geared toward phonics, phonemic awareness, spelling, reading, and writing.

Reading fluently allows students to focus their attention on understanding the meaning of text. Readers who are fluent read words with automaticity. They read accurately, they read with expression, and they read at an appropriate rate. Develop students' fluency by having them practice with the Fluency Centers.

My "Literacy Centers That Work" model is structured around 6-7 work centers that students visit while the teacher meets with guided reading or other literacy small groups. Reading , writing, speaking, and listening are the foundations of the centers activities in this framework.

A learning center is a space set aside in the classroom that allows easy access to a variety of learning materials in an interesting and productive manner. Learning centers are usually designed to offer a variety of materials, designs, and media through which students can work by themselves or with others to operationalize the information learned in the classroom.

Learning or rotation centers are places where students can self-direct their learning —usually in pairs or small groups—within the classroom. These designated spaces allow children to work collaboratively by accomplishing activities given an allotted amount of time and rotating to the next center after they have each completed a task.

Learning centers are used by early childhood educators to teach important concepts in math, language and reading. Reading centers allow small groups of kindergartners to practice literacy skills with hands-on activities like manipulating letters, looking at and discussing books or playing rhyming games.
