The Basics of Winning Bridge

The object in bridge play is to win tricks for your side. A trick consists of four cards, one from each player in turn, clockwise around the table. Hence, there are 13 tricks to be won on each deal. The first card played to each trick is called the lead.

Learn To Play Bridge!

Simplerebid of your first suit(1C - 1H -2C) -- Extra length (usually a 6+cards) and a minimum (13-15 points). To show a stronger hand with a longsuit, you can jump-rebid your suit -- 1C - 1H -3C. Singleraise of partner's suit(1C - 1H -2H) -- 4 cards in the suit partnerresponded and a minimum (13-15 points).
