A more complete version of this gospel can be found in the Berlin Codex, originally discovered in the late 19 th century in Upper Egypt.

Answer: The Gospel of Mary was discovered in the Akhmim Codex in Cairo, Egypt, in 1896. It was not made public until 1955, when it was published due to the popularity of the Nag Hammadi library.
